MADE IN SOUTH LONDON

Earlier in October we had a stand at the Made in South London Opportunities Fair which took place at Crystal Palace Football Club. This was hosted by the Palace for Life Foundation who support young people in South London.

We loved speaking with hundreds of young people about different job roles and the types of skills that are relevant for those careers. Our alphabet activity once again got everyone thinking and talking about some lesser known and exciting careers!

It was fantastic to see large groups from our Croydon Schools enjoying the day, speaking to employers and local service providers and taking part in speed networking sessions.

The evening saw a panel discussion with some key figures in the community as well as representatives from Samaritans and Metropolitan Police. The panel and audience explored how to engage young people to take part in opportunities available to them and how we can better steer young people away from crime.
