We hope you have had an amazing summer! We are looking forward to working with you again this year to continue building relationships and support your Careers Programme. This newsletter includes some excellent resources and reminders to help you kick off this school year.

#### Launching START in London - FREE LMI Platform

We are excited to launch this as a **FREE** resource to schools/colleges in South London. The <u>Start in London</u> is a collaboration between the Careers Hub and UExplore to offer a bespoke platform with up-to-date local labour market information that meets key Gatsby benchmarks including 2, 3 and 4 by:

- Connecting your students with their future employers
- Using real-world labour market information to aid career planning
- Linking teaching with employability and careers learning

The structured content includes:

- A page for each borough with a series of 'local stories' to help students to think about jobs linked to things around them.
- A guide to making post 16 and post 18 choices with links to local providers and courses
- Students populate their **StartProfile**, which can be used to support careers interventions, 1–2–1 guidance, as well as helping get students employment ready.
- A <u>delivery plan</u>, lesson plans, power points for teachers and student worksheets – to make it as easy for you to embed the platform.
