What to expect from the service?

You will receive specialist one to one support from a dedicated Employment Specialist who gets to know you, your goals and your needs. This includes:

Vocational Profiling and personalised Action Plan.

Rapid Job Searching with access to a wide range of employers.

Health related interventions.

Disclosure support.

Job specific CV and Cover Letter creation.

Mock interviews.

Better-off calculation and Benefits Advice.

Travel planning.

Ongoing in-work support.

Career progression and development support once in-work.

Who Can Join Connect to Work?

You can take part if you're 18 or over, live in Richmond, and are either out of work or struggling to stay in work due to health or personal challenges.

The programme supports people with disabilities, health conditions, or those facing barriers such as caring responsibilities, homelessness, criminal justice experience, substance dependency, or being a refugee, care leaver or survivor of abuse.
